From April 1, 2023, Editorial Manager®(EM) will be introduced as AJHS's submission and peer review system. EM® has been adopted by more than 7,600 publications from various publishers around the world and is one of the most widely used submission and peer review systems in the world. From now on, all submissions will only be accepted through EM®. Please note that we cannot accept direct submissions to the AJHS Editorial Office email. If you plan to submit, you will need to register a new ID and password. Please check our Privacy Policy when registering. The submission format will be new Article format the October 2023 (Vol.25).
